Job Title: Senior Locksmith

Summary

- Function: To provide advanced journeyman level skills in the repair, resetting, and installation of locking devices and the manufacture of keys.
- Scope: Responsible for repairing, rebuilding, and resetting locks and for cutting keys for locks in buildings, cabinets and lockers.

Duties

- Typical:
 1. Installs, programs and maintains computerized lock systems.
 2. Performs locksmith duties to include making keys for padlocks, doors, lockers, desks and cabinets; selecting key blanks, cuts and fits keys to locks; unlocks locks when keys are lost or broken; changes the combination and resets locks for more than one key; and cleans, changes, adjusts, services, rebuilds and resets all types of locks and locking equipment.
 3. Performs preventative maintenance and repairs on computerized lock system hardware.
 4. Maintains and updates locklink computer program.
 5. Organizes and maintains records, orders replacement parts and supplies and completes necessary administrative documentation.
 6. Completes work orders to show work done; provides maintenance advice to faculty and staff.
 7. Provides consultation and estimates regarding costs associated with access control hardware, software, labor and services.
 8. Receives DSX programming requests and provides access in a timely manner.
 9. Performs other duties as assigned.
- Periodic:
 1. Cleans and oils machines used in locksmith and machine work.
 2. Provides training to other locksmiths.
