Summary

- Function: To provide the advanced technical skills required to generate, modify, and maintain computer system software within defined limits.
- Scope: Responsible for assisting in the generation and installation of operating system software and in the development and implementation of modifications to the existing operating system.

Duties

- Typical:
 1. Analyzes existing and projected operating systems and procedures, including studies of the interaction of several software systems to ascertain feasibility and performance.
 2. Coordinates implementation, installation, and maintenance of software and hardware, insuring operational efficiency.
 3. Maintains production databases and provides support and problem resolution to system users.
 4. Develops and produces web sites and web applications.
 5. Assists with report generation database backup and recovery.
 6. Coordinates with system administrators, developers and management regarding database needs and usage.
 7. Advises software system specialists of lower grade with respect to determination, and possible solutions to, work problems.
 8. Performs other duties as assigned.

 1. Assists in training other systems software personnel and end users.
