Summary

- Function: To provide oversight of a comprehensive web site for a large unit and directly related web sites.
- Scope: Responsible for the day-to-day maintenance, compliance, and continuity of a comprehensive web site and directly related web sites.

Duties

- Typical:
 1. Administers and maintains a comprehensive web site and continuity among directly related web sites.
 2. Coordinate the implementation and administration of on-line programs and services and servers and server applications.
 3. Develops and ensures compliance with applicable policies on web site usage, security and standards.
 4. Troubleshoots and provides problem resolution to users on the use of web applications and in the use of computer technologies. Updates web maintenance hardware and software.
 5. Designs and teaches courses regarding web applications and administration.
 6. Perform other duties as assigned.
- Periodic:
 1. Evaluates new web client technologies and web applications. Conducts research and recommends web-based applications.
 2. Work on special projects as assigned.
